

NASHVILLE TRIP COMMITMENT FORM

The W.T. Woodson Choral Department is traveling to Nashville, TN April 15-19, 2020. We will depart late in the evening on April 15 from W.T. Woodson, drive overnight and arrive in Nashville the following morning. We will drive over night on April 18 and return to Woodson HS early morning on April 19. Please read through all information. The cost is projected to not exceed \$680/person.

This price includes all travel costs, two nights in a hotel including 2 breakfasts, 1 dinner, Riverfront tours, a performance at the Grand Ole Opry, a vocal clinic at Vanderbilt University, entrance to the country music hall of fame, a lesson in line dancing, a visit to Belmont University, a music writing workshop, and other local sites. Students will be absent for two school days (April 16 & 17).
